

A note on uniforms

Please note:

Please ensure that the **formal black school shoes** are in WHS standards: Black leather/polishable school shoes with black laces (not boots, fabric or slip on shoes) [Velcro is preferred for K-2]

Sports shoes are **black joggers** with black laces, no colour/branding (not boots, fabric or slip on shoes)

All **socks** should be plain with no branding.

Sport Days for Year 7-10 will be Tuesday and Friday

Primary days – TBA early 2018

Repeated breaches of non-uniform compliance will be noted and dealt with appropriately.

Please help us avoid UNIFORM WARNINGS AND DETENTIONS by having the correct items purchased for your child.

At times, students are wearing items that are not part of the uniform. With this package, you would have received the 2018 uniforms' list. A list is also available by email or at the office, and is in the student diaries for long term reference.

School specific items are available at Lowes, Grafton.

Here are some featured points:

- **Shoes:** Shoes should be all black with black laces. Formal - leather/polishable. Shoes must be enclosed and cover the top of the foot. Sports shoes must be black joggers with no colours/branding. **Boots, fabric or slip on shoes are unacceptable.**
- **Socks** should be plain and free of branding.
- **School hats:** compulsory year round for K-6 students. **School caps** are an item for secondary only. For secondary, 7-12, school hats or caps are optional during general outdoor time but are highly recommended. Year 7-12 students are required to wear the school hat or cap for PDHPE, Sport Studies, Sport and outdoor activities planned by their teacher.
- **Girl's skirt length: (7-12 skirts)** the secondary skirts must be knee length. Girls are not permitted to have skirts hemmed higher than at the knee or to roll them at the waist.
- **White blouses:** The girls are required to wear flesh bras under their white blouses. A flesh/white singlet is also appropriate.
- **Jackets:** Only school sanctioned jackets are to be worn (including on the bus to and from school). No hoodies or alternative jackets are permitted. The sloppy-joe with crest is a primary item.

If your child is out of uniform for any reason, please jot a note in their diary, send an email or call the office – this very quickly helps us understand that you are aware that your child is out of uniform.
